A RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE CARBON COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

WHEREAS, The County Board of Elections is charged with selecting and fixing the polling place of each election district under Section 2726 of the Election Code; and

WHEREAS, Due to the current Declaration of Emergency related to the COVID-19 pandemic, the number of available election officials require the Board of Elections to consider consolidation of polling places within the County; and

WHEREAS, The County Board of Elections has determined it is in the best interest of public health, safety, and welfare to consolidate polling places for the 2020 Primary Election.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Carbon County Board of Elections in accordance with 25 P.S. §2726 hereby adopts consolidation of the applicable voting districts as listed.


