



**RESOLUTION
NO. 20-017**

A RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY
OF CARBON, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA FOR REAL ESTATE PROPERTY
TAX RELIEF PURSUANT TO SENATE BILL 841

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 841 has been duly enacted by the Legislature of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, Subchapter B of said Bill adopts authority for property tax relief; and

WHEREAS, Section 5712 provides that the Bill is applicable to a defined "Taxing District" which includes the "County of any class in this Commonwealth"; and

WHEREAS, Section 5713 provides for said County to enact real property tax relief as provided in Section 5713(a):

"Notwithstanding any other law and subject to subsection (b)"

A Taxing District may, by majority vote of the Taxing District's governing body...;"

(2) Waive any fee or penalty otherwise associated with the late payment of the tax if paid in full by December 31, 2020"; and

WHEREAS, Such action is required to be enacted by Resolution adopted by the governing body and delivered to the Tax Collector for the Taxing District within thirty (30) days of the effective date; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Carbon that the date for imposition of the Ten Percent (10%) penalty associated with late payment of real estate taxes duly levied and imposed by the Board of Commissioners will be waived for Fiscal Year 2020 if paid in full on or before November 1, 2020; and

RESOLVED, The County Administrator shall cause a copy of this Resolution to be delivered to all Tax Collectors collecting County real estate taxes immediately upon adoption of this Resolution; and

RESOLVED, This Resolution shall be adopted the date of enactment herein.




