WORK RELEASE DIRECTOR FRANK SHUBECK SUBMITTED HIS MONTHLY REPORT.

WARDEN'S REPORT

ACTING WARDEN BANTA SUBMITTED HER MONTHLY REPORT TO THE BOARD FOR REVIEW. SHE REPORTED THE FIRST ROUND OF THE COVID VACCINE HAD BEEN SUCCESSFULLY ADMINISTERED ON JUNE 23RD AND JUNE 30TH. A TOTAL OF FIFTY-NINE INMATES HAD THEIR FIRST VACCINE.
